Greenway joins Ferris campus police

BIG RAPIDS – Nicholas T. Greenway is the newest addition to the Ferris State University Department of Public Safety. He comes to Ferris after spending the past four years as a law enforcement officer with the Lake County Sheriff's Office.

Officer Greenway will participate with the department's other men and women to enforce laws and ordinances as a licensed Michigan police officer, said Police Chief Martin J. Bledsoe, director of public safety. He, like all of the department's officers, will be most visible around campus in his service role.

"His knowledge of and past history with community policing as a philosophy helped him stand out among the candidates for this position," Bledsoe said. "Please join us in welcoming Officer Nick Greenway to our campus community."

Greenway replaces officer Daniel J. Newman, who left the department for another career pursuit late last year. Greenway was sworn in on Feb. 15.
